Michigan Army National Guard to Update Grayling Residents on PFAS Investigation

A town hall meeting will be held on Tuesday, May 10, 2022, from 6:00 – 8:00 p.m. at Kirtland Community College in Community Room A. An open house session will be held during the hour prior to the meeting, all representatives will be present during this time to answer questions.

The Army National Guard will provide an update on the continuing investigations of PFAS contamination at and near Camp Grayling and the Grayling Army Airfield (GAAF). The agenda for this meeting will also include an update on the drinking water sampling, discussion about upcoming field work at Camp Grayling and the GAAF, and presentation of findings from various investigations around Camp Grayling.

Representatives from the National Guard Bureau, District Health Department #10, and the Michigan Departments of: Environment, Great Lakes, and Energy (EGLE), Health and Human Services (MDHHS), and Military and Veterans Affairs (DMVA) will be in attendance for this meeting and the open house session.
